Note: The FA Cup Qualifying Rounds were changed in 1925 and from 1925-26 onwards Football League clubs at Tier 3 were given exemption until the First Round Proper. In 1924-25 Rovers played in the FA Cup as a Football League club in Division 3 North. Qualifying Rounds 5 and 6 equated to what are now the First Round Proper. Therefore, for the purposes of determining a Senior Game, the FA Cup ties against Rotherham County (Q5, 29/11/1924) and against Southport (Q6, 13/12/1924) ARE counted as senior games. The 4Q tie against Mansfield Town (15/11/1924) is NOT counted as a senior game.
